WSDOT 2017 Chip Seal Project Schedule 6/12-6/16:

The Washington State Department of Transportation will be continuing their prep work for the planned chip seal project along State Route 903. During the week of June 12-16 (most likely June 12), WSDOT will be completing the bridge deck overlay on the Crystal Creek Bridge at the SR 903 and Stafford Avenue in Cle Elum. Activities are expected to cause travel delays so drivers should plan accordingly. WSDOT will also be working on similar bridge projects throughout the Hwy 10 corridor during the same time period.

WSDOT Temporary Shutdowns of Indian John Hill Rest Area: June-October

The WSDOT Peoh Road Bridge to Elk Heights Road Vicinity concrete rehabilitation project on westbound I-90 will need to shut down westbound Indian John Hill Rest Area intermittently from early June through the summer and potentially as late as October. As an interim measure, a temporary rest area will be set up in a gravel area to the south of Cle Elum's Wye Park on the south side of Railroad Street between Oakes Avenue and South Cle Elum Way. This area is anticipated to receive high traffic volumens during peak travel times and will be accessible 24-hours per day during Indian John Hill Rest Area temporary closures.
