

What is Land Use?

■ The Land Use Element (including text and a map) describes the location, distribution, and extent of different land uses.

Example Land Uses include:



Parks & Open Space



Single Family Residential



General Commercial

What is Zoning?

- Zoning is a development regulation that implements Land Use planning. Every parcel falls into a specific zone.
- Zoning can be used to determine minimum lot sizes, setbacks, permitted uses (i.e. single family home vs. apartment complex or factory vs. movie theater), and a variety of other things.

Example Zones includes:



Single Family Residential



Entry Commercial



Multi-Family Residential



Land Use & Zoning Compatibility

- A parcel's Zoning must be consistent with the Land Use designation. If it is inconsistent, the Comprehensive Plan must be amended.
- Remember, Land Use is the plan and Zoning is the implementation of the plan, so Land Use determines where specific
 - zones can be located.
- E.g. Single Family Land Use allow for Single Family, Multi-Family or Planned Mixed Use Zoning.
