The City of Cle Elum is inviting Statements of Qualifications (SOQ) from firms interested in providing professional engineering including planning for the **Columbia Avenue Extension Railroad Crossing Feasibility Study**. The feasibility study will include right of way, equity, Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railway coordination, environmental, and funding exploration. The total project cost including all professional services is approximately \$65,600.

SOQs for this solicitation shall be limited to twenty (20) pages excluding a one-page cover letter and front and back covers (if used). Selection criteria will include key personnel; experience with right of way and surveys, environmental considerations, and community equity; experience with identifying funding opportunities; experience with Cle Elum; and past performance/references. SOQs will be evaluated on a competitive basis using the above criteria. The jurisdiction will score the received SOQs and may conduct interviews. Two (2) copies of the SOQs shall be received at City Hall by 10:00 a.m., Thursday, September 28, 2023.
